**BROAD SCOPE OF POSITION:** These positions report to the Human Resources Specialist / Manager (or designee), and works collaboratively with other Consultant – Staff Interpreters to provide the highest possible quality sign language interpreting services for Colorado School for the Deaf and the Blind (CSDB) staff and students in a variety of situations.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university, with formal interpreter training, coursework in Deaf Education and/or Child Development preferred. Suitable substitutions consist of: an Associate's Degree from a formal Interpreter Preparation Program and a combination of related education/experience equivalent to two (2) years; or a combination of related education/experience which provided the same level of knowledge (i.e., four (4) years of professional interpreting experience)
- RID (Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf) Certification – CI and CT (Certified Interpreter and Certified Transliterator) and/or National Interpreter Certification (NIC)
- Five (5) years of diverse interpreting experience (excluding educational interpreting)
- Preferred: Hold or be eligible for (and willing/able to obtain) Educational Interpreter (EI) Authorization in the State of Colorado
- Proficiency in American Sign Language (ASL) at the Advanced Plus or better skill level as demonstrated by an appropriate assessment tool and according to school policy

**Terms of Employment:**

- Part-Time (0.4 fte); scheduled to work 15-20 hours per week (subject to change) during the academic year, as per established School Calendar (August to June).
- Employment is at-will, with no actual, expressed, or implied contract.
